

Airfoiler Meeting Minutes

April 2018

The April club meeting of the Coffee Airfoilers was held April 2nd, 2018 at the Saint Barnabas Church, Tullahoma Tennessee. Club President Don Cleveland called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. There were 16 members present.

Gravel Purchase for work day: Scott Darrin reported at the March Meeting that 2 truck loads of 3/4" gravel would be \$960. A discussion was held regarding the need for 3/4" gravel. Harold Jackson stated that gravel that large would not pack into the drive, it would be pushed off the driveway by vehicles traveling in and out of the field. Harold recommended 1/2" gravel be purchased instead. Don Cleveland asked Scott Darrin to check on the price of 1/2" gravel for the driveway.

Pay-Pal as an option to pay dues on the Web site: Mike Jenkins had brought up Pay-Pal at the February meeting. Mike had presented the costs to the club officers in March. Club Vice-President Paul Green presented the costs and findings Mike Jenkins had received from Pay-pal. After some discussion, Club President Don Cleveland asked for a motion and a second to table the Pay-pal idea. Motion made and approved.

Trailer Purchase: Club Vice-President Paul Green reported looking at a trailer in Knoxville which met the cost & requirements of the club. Due to some serious condition issues, no offer was made to purchase the trailer. Several tips were offered for possible locations for a trailer including Tri-Une Trailer Sales & Rocket City Trailer Sales.
