

# Airfoiler Meeting Minutes

## June 2017

The June meeting of the Coffee Airfoilers was held on June 5th, 2017, at the club field. Club president called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. eighteen members were present.

The financial report was presented by club treasurer Bonny Jenkins. Bonny presented a detailed report of the club's May spending. She also offered a print copy to any member wishing to read the report themselves. Bonny further reported on our membership. She reported 93 paid members to date. This is up four members from the April report. A motion to accept the financial report was made and approved.

## Old Business

Field Maintenance: Scott Darrin. As agreed at the May meeting, June 10th will be a work day to set the new gate post. Ernie stated he would come earlier in the week to bore the hole for the gate post. After some discussion, the members agreed on the purchase of an 8 foot pole for the gate. Club vice president Paul Green agreed to purchase the post from ACE Fence Co., McMinnville, Tn. Don Cleveland suggested that the two donated park-style grills be installed on June 10th as well. After some discussion, everyone agreed that the grills be installed with concrete next to the current fire pits. Ernie Miller agreed to cut the holes for the grills as well. George Schmidt requested that the holes for two new giant scale run up stations also be cut on the work day. Ernie stated it would be no problem, just clearly mark the locations of the requested holes. In all, plans were laid to install the post for the new gate, two grills, two run up stations and two new speed limit signs.

Spring A.L.E.S. May 6th & 7th, 2017. CD Harold Jackson. Harold reported that the weather was a little uncooperative for the event. There were 11 registered pilots for the event. It netted \$500.00. After expenses, \$257.64 was added to the treasury.

New chairs. Ernie Mille. Ernie stated he purchased seven new chairs for the club at the cost of \$207.27, only \$7.27 more than the expenditure approved at the May meeting!

## New Business

New picnic Tables. Ernie Miller stated he had located composite tables at COSCO for approximately \$130.00 each. Don Cleveland stated the cost of resurfacing the current tables with composite lumber would approximately \$200.00, based on the Lowe's cost of \$25.00 for an 8' board. 8 boards are required for each table. A motion was made to buy two new picnic tables. Motion was approved. Ernie will purchase the tables for the club.

Longest Day Picnic. Don Cleveland. Don stated David Green, who normally CDs the picnic, asked about which meat the club should serve this year. After a brief discussion, Boston Butts were suggested and approved. The picnic will be at 5:00pm.
