

Airfoiler Meeting Minutes

September 2015

The September meeting of the Coffee Airfoilers was held September 14th, 2015 at the club field. 21 members were present. Club president Don Cleveland called the meeting to order at 6:54pm.

The financial report was presented by club treasurer Harold Jackson. Harold also reported we now have 98 club members, up from 96 at the August meeting. A motion was made to approve, seconded and passed.

Old Business

Model Aviation Day. CD Don Cleveland. Don reported we made and donated more to the AMA in support of the Wounded Warrior Project than we were able to donate in 2014. Don asked the membership if we wanted to continue to donate to the Wounded Warrior Project or select a new charity, maybe something more local. Donating to the Wounded Airman Fund was suggested, more to follow on this charity, and possibly others.

Giant Scale Fun Fly. CD George Schmidt. The two day event raised \$1220 for the club with 37 registered pilots participating.

Float Fly. CD Ernie Miller. There were 10 registered pilots. The event raised \$100 for the club.

Lease for our flying site. President Don Cleveland. Our lease expires in 2016 with the Air Force. We are filing our extension paperwork. The Air Force will perform a site inspection as part of the process.

New Business

Airport Notification requirement (FAA mandate) President Don Cleveland. The AMA sent a sample notification letter for our club to notify our local airport of our flying. Don will handle the notifications.

Field Maintenance Committee. Chairman George Schmidt. George suggested we fill in a hole in the runway which currently limits how far we can land to the north on the grass runway. This will allow us to extend the usable grass runway

approximately 200 feet to the north, making it easier to land giant scale airplanes when the wind is from the north. It will also eliminate problems with giant scale airplanes flying over the gun range, as the pilots will be able to adjust their flight paths away from the gun range. George suggested it may cost \$500 to complete the project. Don requested more cost details so the membership could vote on a motion at the October meeting.

Show and Tell

There was nothing for show and tell, but Charlie Myers introduced a guest who attended the meeting with him, Jim Willard.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 pm.
