## **Airfoiler Meeting Minutes**

The August meeting of the Coffee Airfoilers was called to order by Don Cleveland at 7:00pm at the airfield. There were 27 members present.

The financial report was presented by club treasurer Bonny J. Bonny detailed August spending and income. Bonny Jenkins reported that the club has 107 paid members. A motion to accept the financial report was made and approved.
